Discordance is the quality of not being in an agreement with somebody or something.

Children of the discordance started in 2011 with 2 of my friends, Kido and Inokawa, created a customized shirt making the one and only piece never seen before. On the weekend we will gather at the atelier, blast hip hop and hard core music and produce original patches and screen prints for our original t-shirts.

I have never wanted to wear something that others were wearing, nor did I want to listen to the same music everybody else is listening to either. I still think and feel this way, so I named the brand "Children of the discordance" just to say I haven't changed at all.

In 2013, Children of the discordance becomes a solo project where I continued on the brand on my own. The vintage bandanas appeared first in 2014, I used a small amount of bandanas on parts of the clothing. Even if the amount of bandanas used were in small amounts, I knew that each bandanas have a distinct pattern that makes each piece unique with different impressions.

After my first encounter with the bandanas, I became more curious about them, I ended up sourcing bandanas from all over the world. Now I use about 20,000 pieces of bandanas in one year for production, and this was made possible by sourcing suppliers from USA, India, Pakistan, France and the Netherlands.

All graphics and textile designs are original, and using the vintage fabrics, having embroidery and everything I do to create the collection is to continue creating the one and only product that expresses the discordance of myself and my creation.
